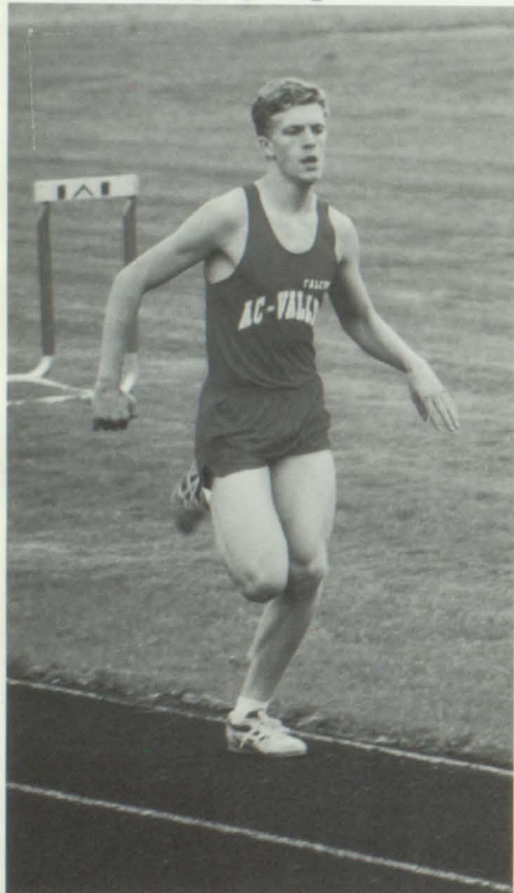


# 1998 Falcon Track

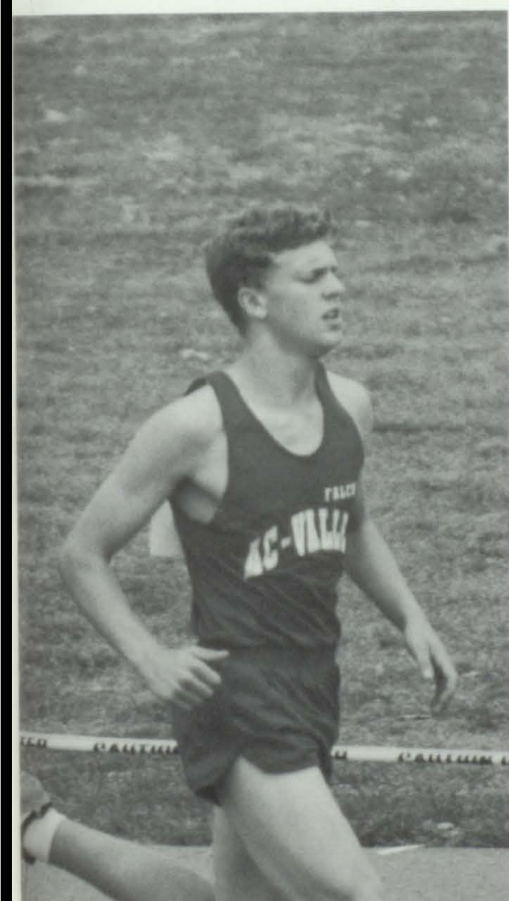

# Girls Track has a successful season

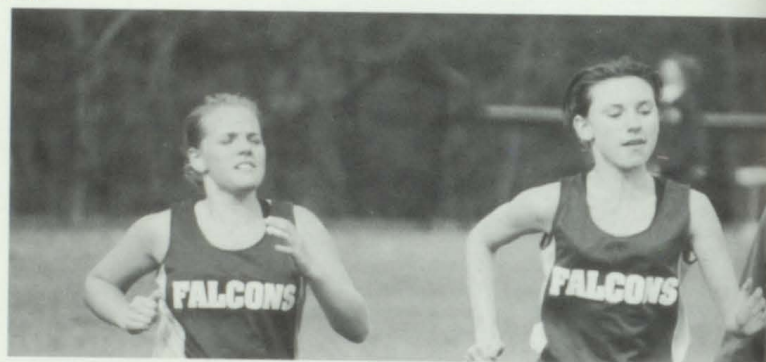

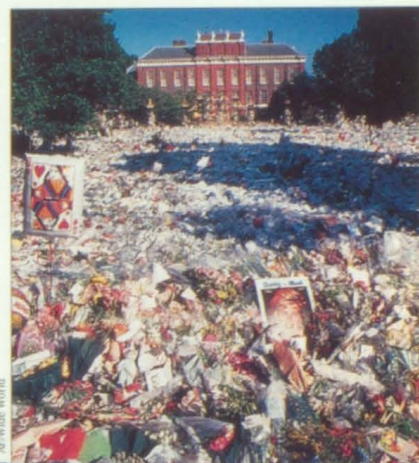

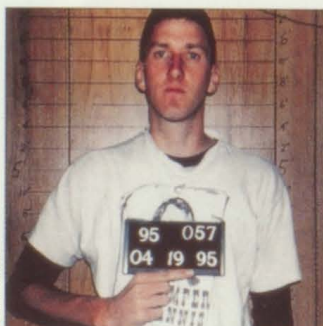

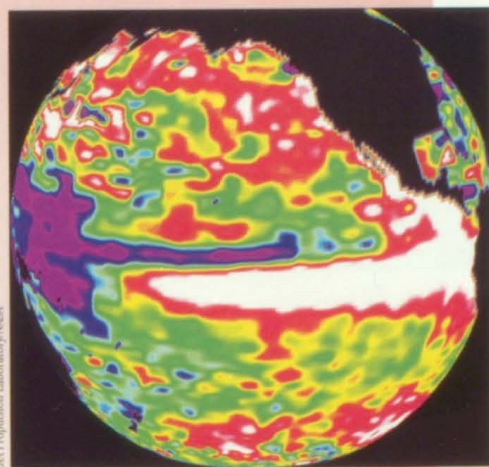

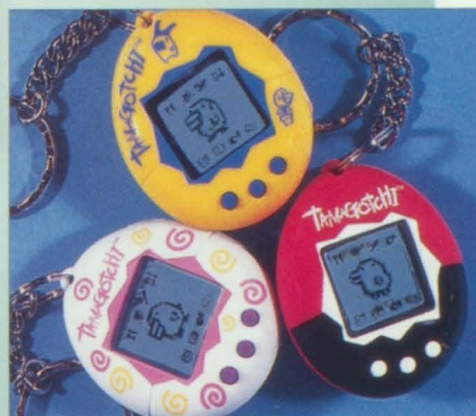

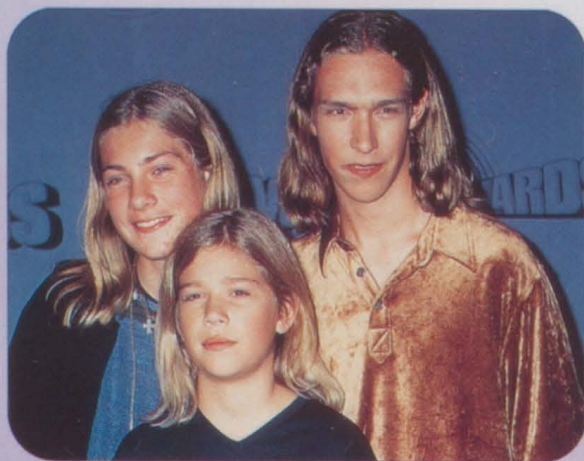

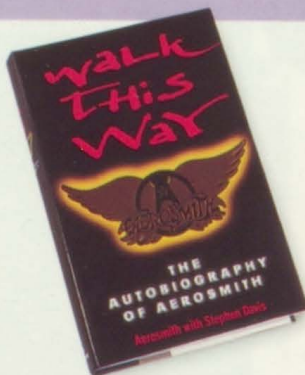

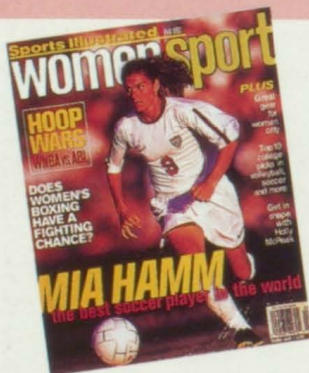

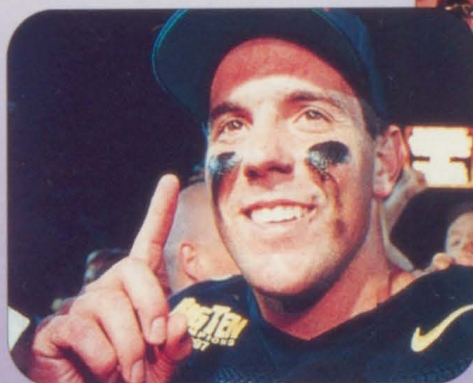

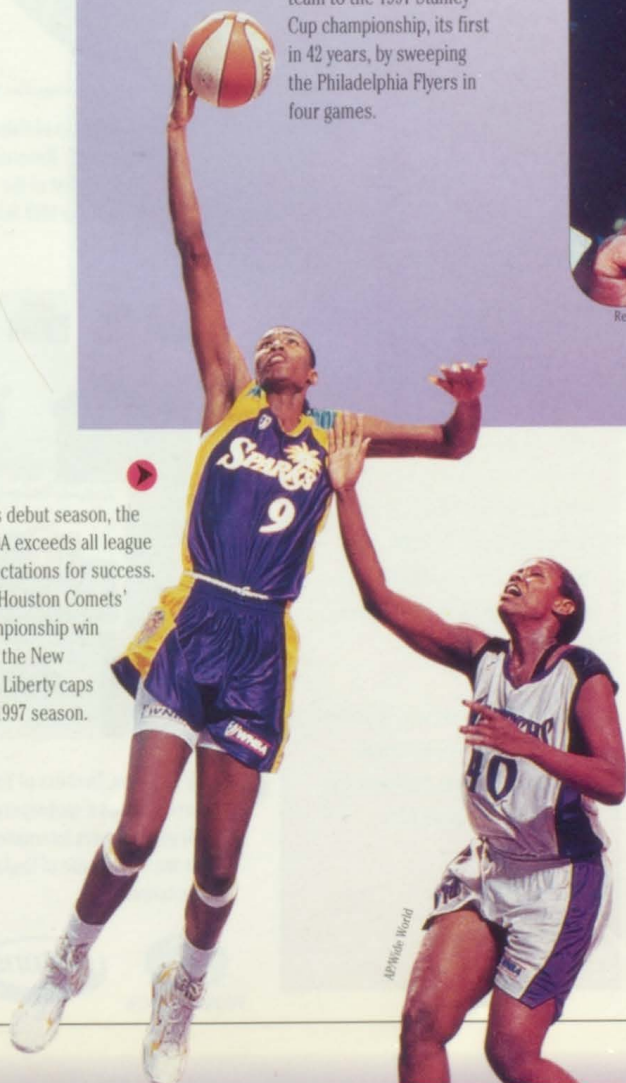
