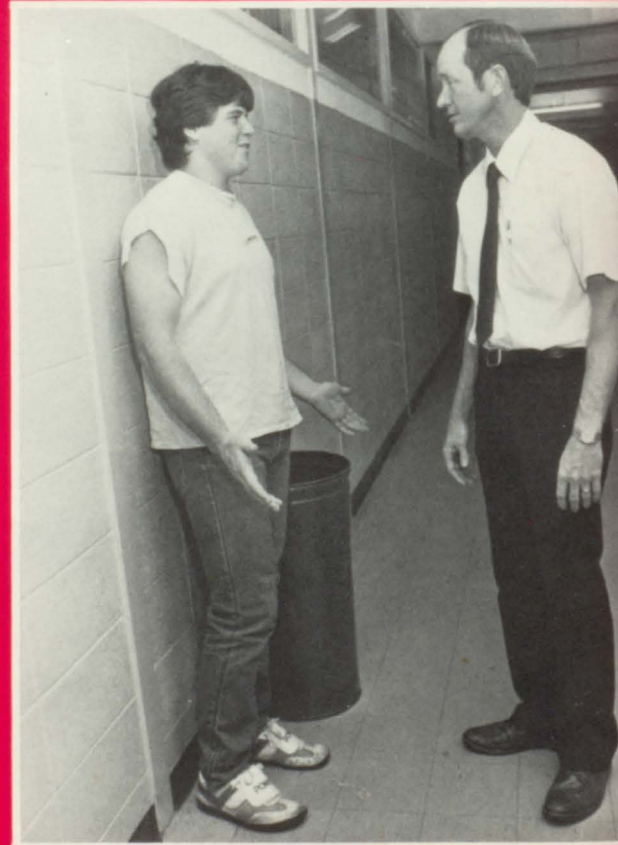


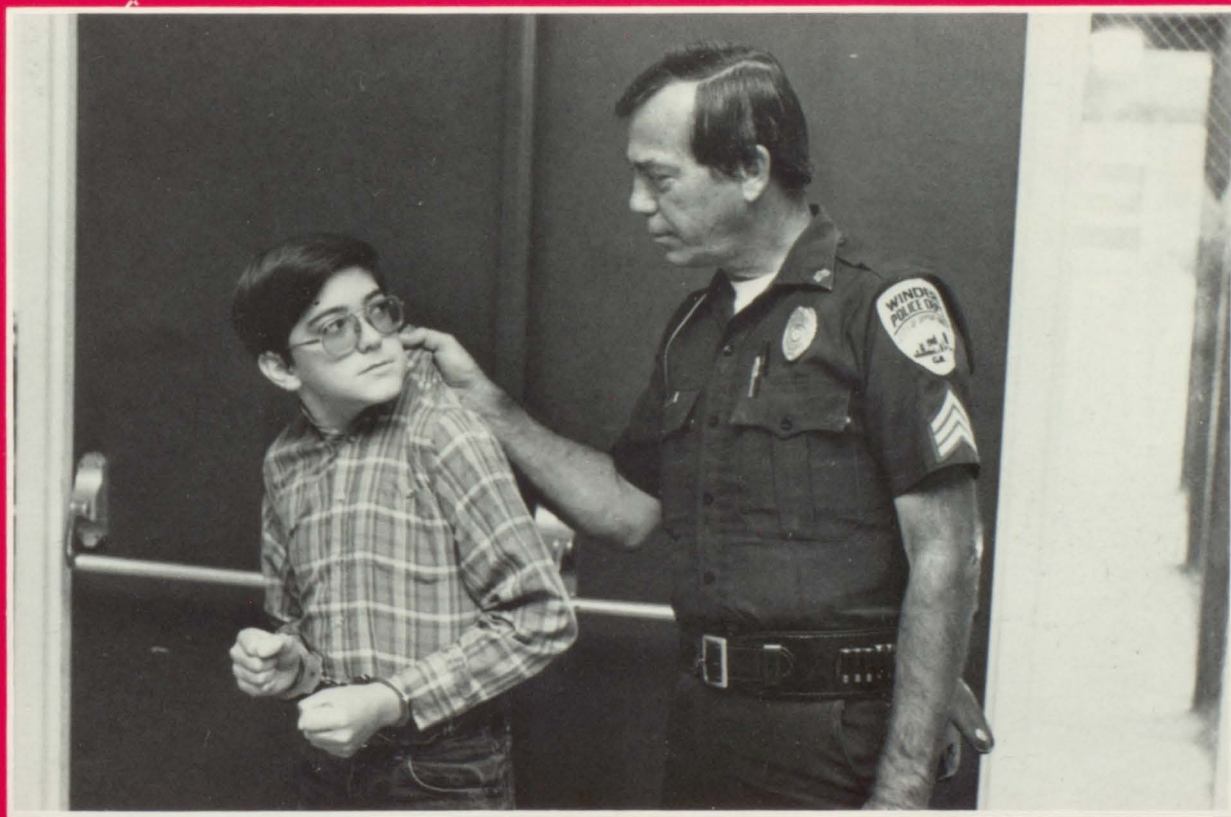
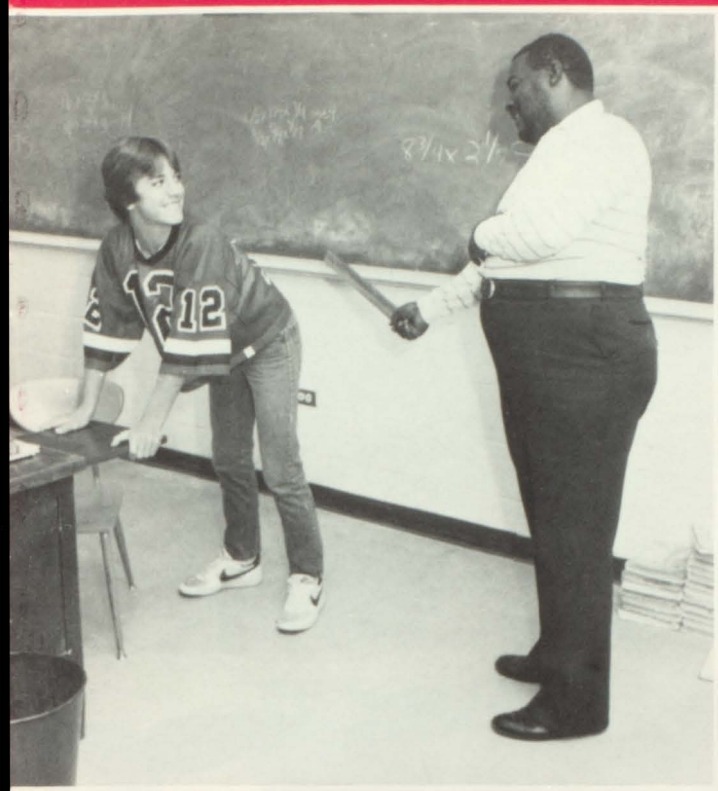
LONG ARM OF THE LAW

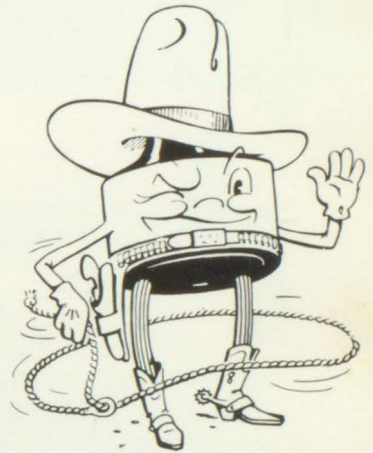




SEARCHING FOR THE FASHION CODE

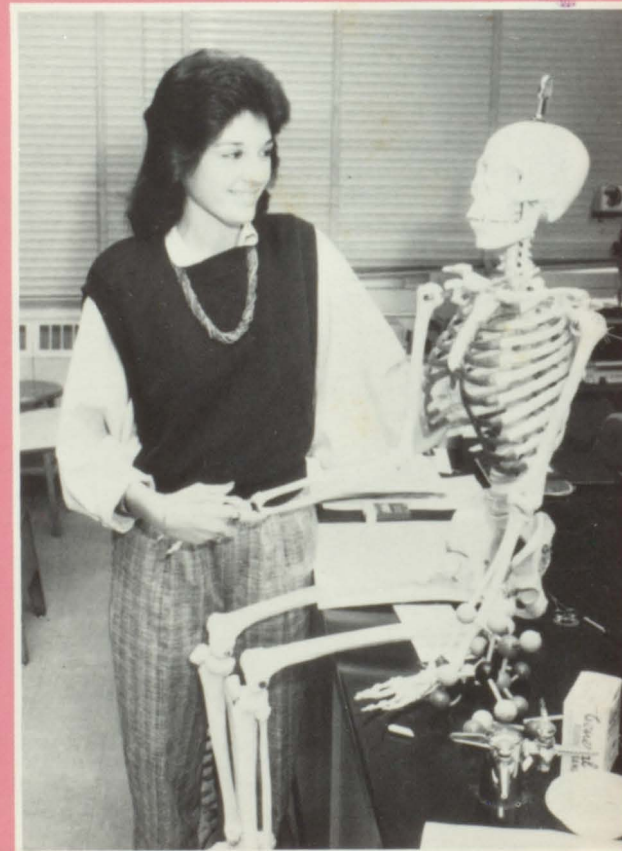


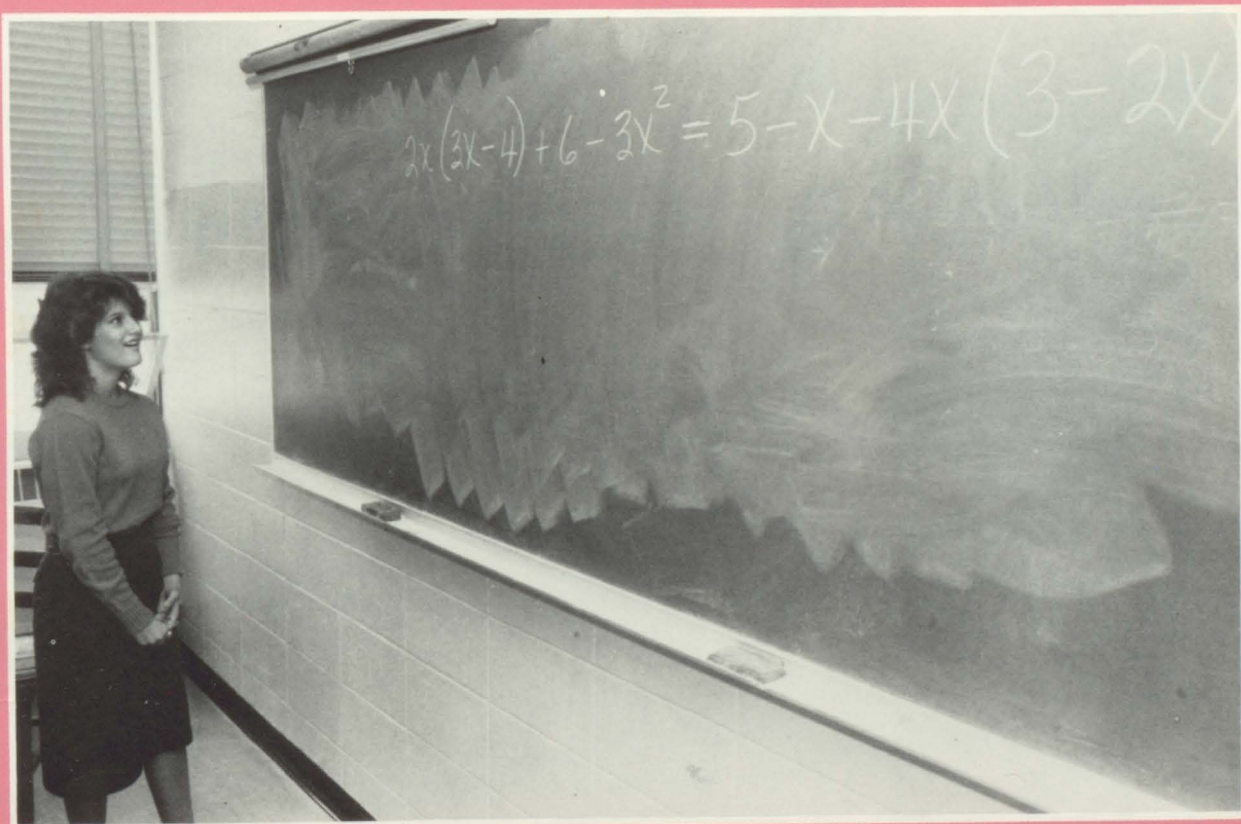
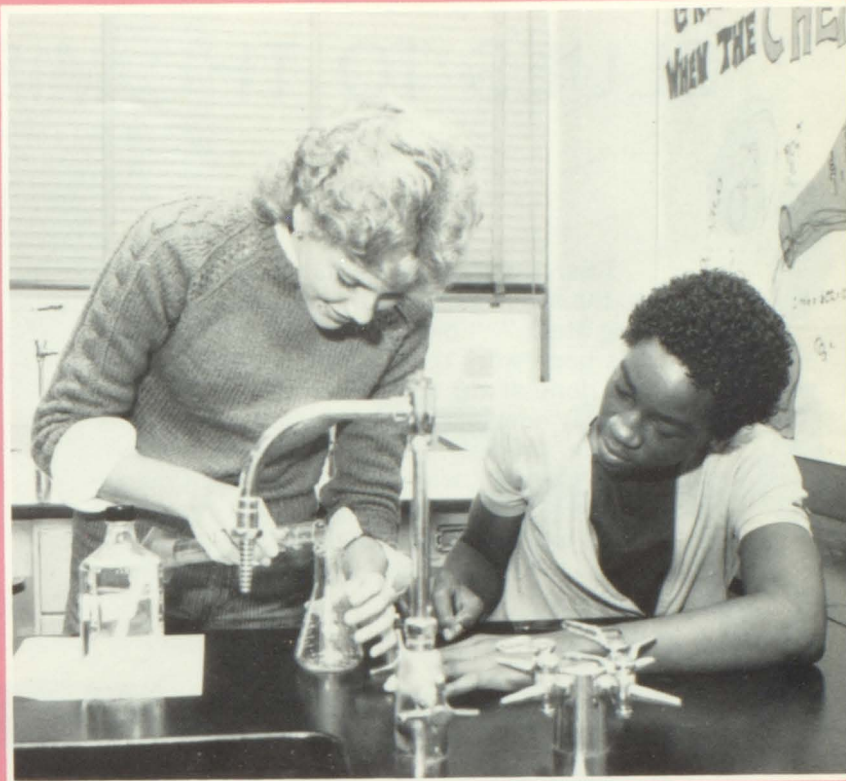
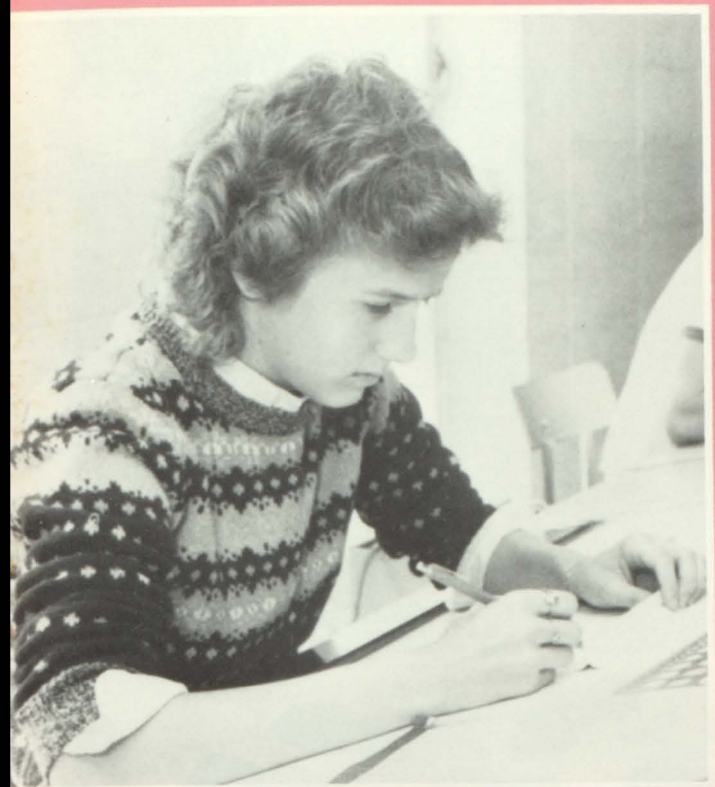


SEARCHING FOR EVIDENCE

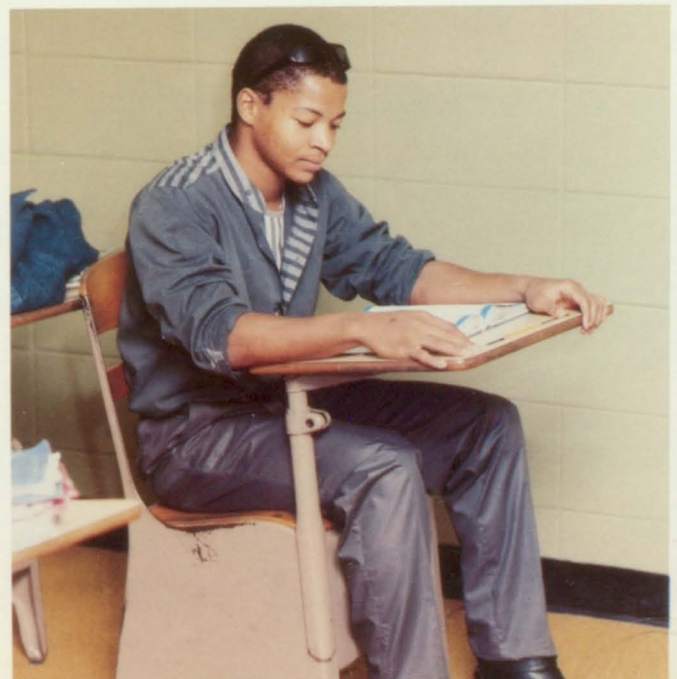
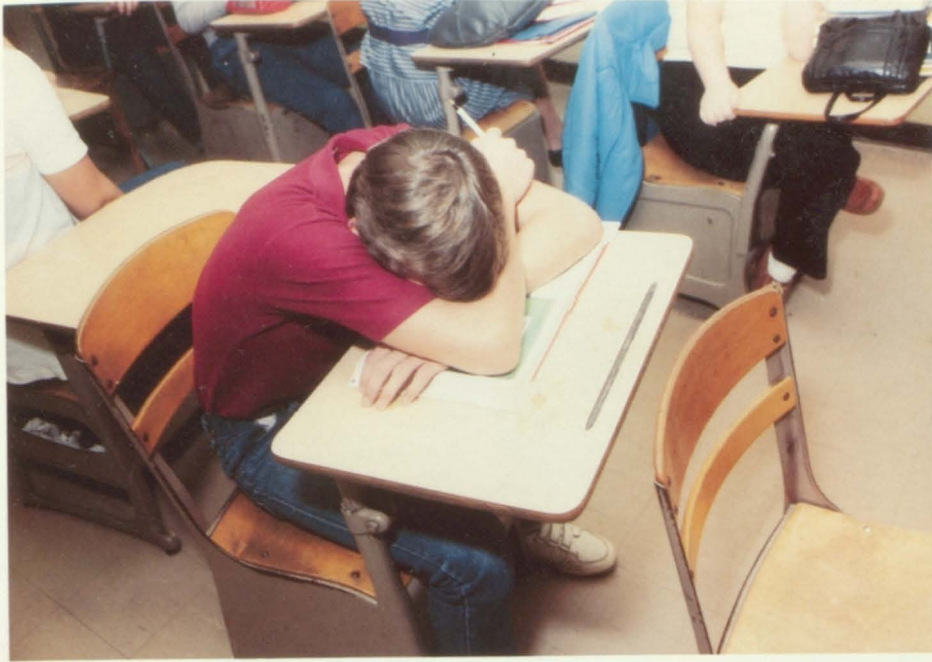




CLUES TO THE MISSING HOMEWORK

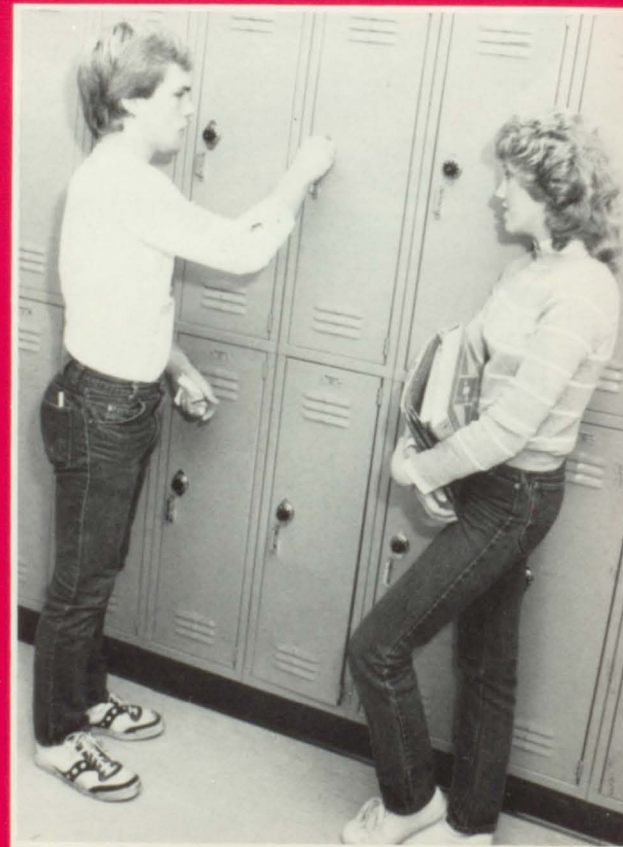
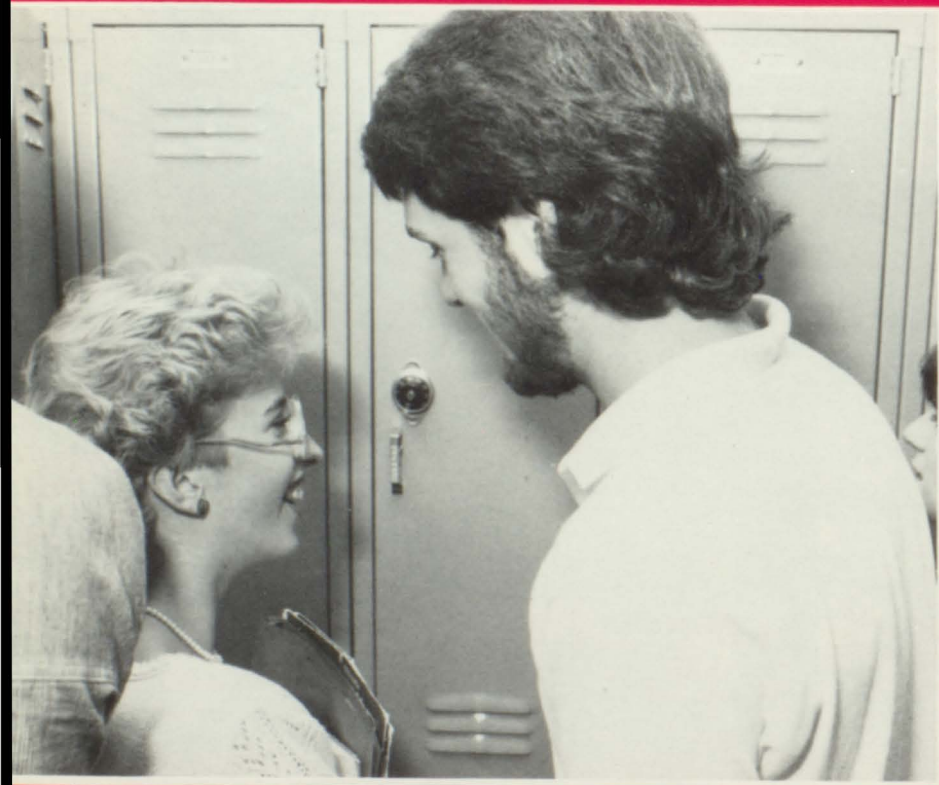




INVESTIGATING CLONES AND COUPLES

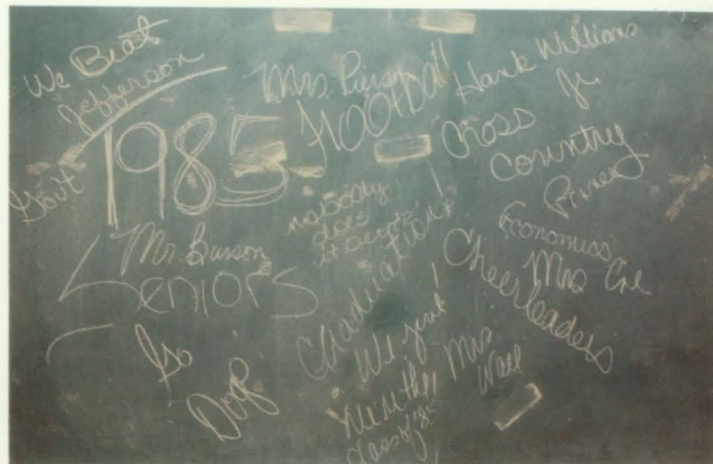




CASE OF THE DISAPPEARING STUDENTS

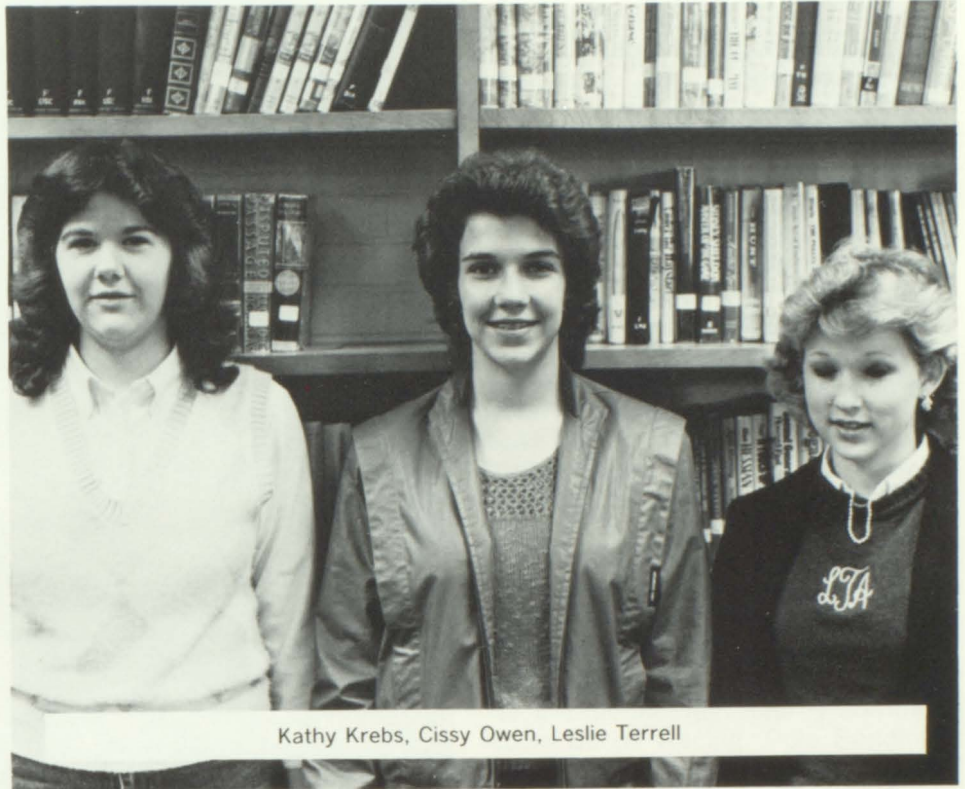
In November, Travis Royster, Tammy Parr, and Eddie Knight, along with advisor, Dana Perkins, of the Winder-Barrow FFA Chapter, attended the National FFA Convention in Kansas City, Missouri, where they competed in the National Dairy Products and Milk Quality Contest. The team, representing WBHS and Georgia placed ninth. Travis was a gold emblem winner, and Tammy and Eddie were silver emblem winners.

In order to compete on the national level, the team had to win the state contest in May. The Winder-Barrow team won the state contest and put many hard, long hours of tasting and studying into this contest before state and especially afterwards.

The three-hour competition is one where a person's sense of taste and smell as well as his knowledge of written material must be up to par. Ten samples of cheese must be identified as to the type. Defects in ten samples of milk must be detected and scored. A contestant must also score ten sediment disks as to the amount of sediment on the disk. Also ten milker unit parts must be scored as to defects found. The final part of the contest is a written multiple choice test with twenty-five questions each on Milk Production and on the Milk Marketing Order.

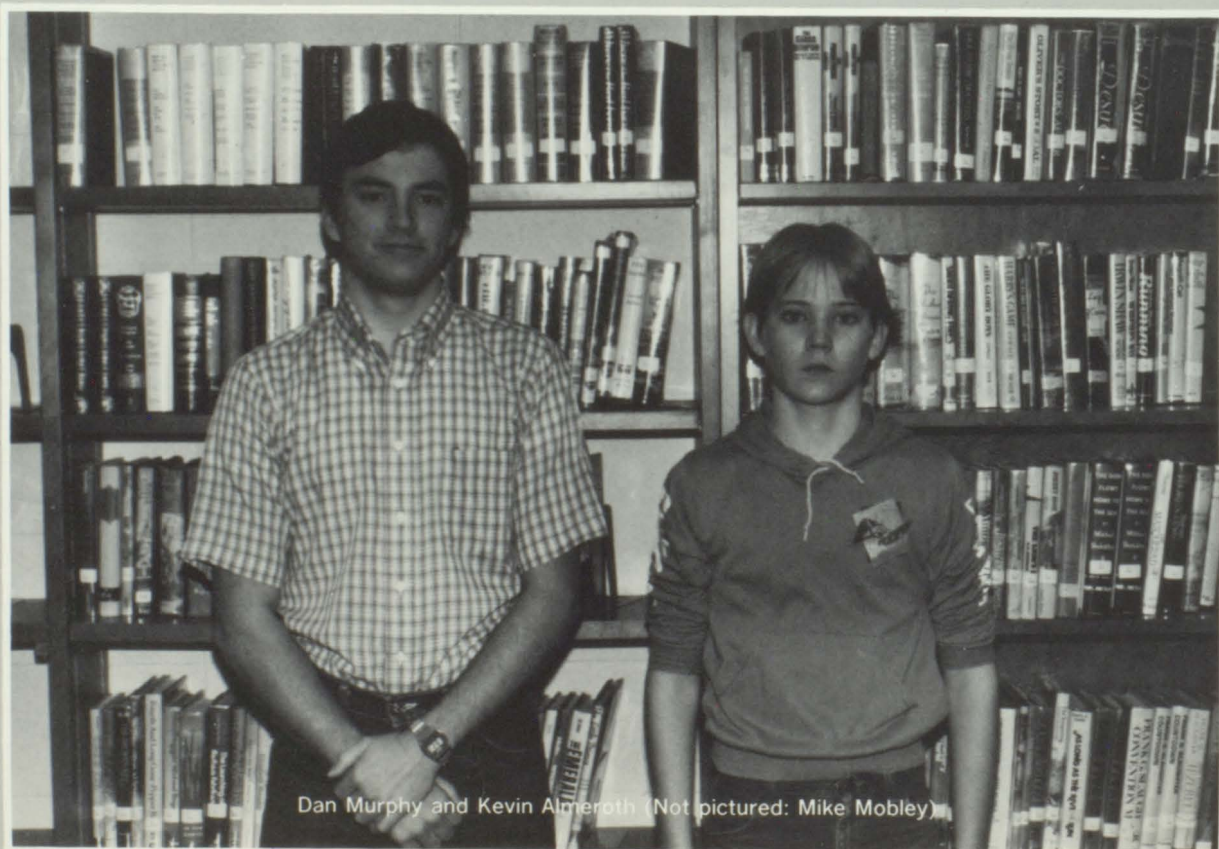
Over the past five years there have been many teachers and approximately 1500 students involved in the activities encompassing these academic programs.
